How to mark or highlight text

Standard Windows Keys: Shift + arrow OR Eclipse command F7 OR Eclipse hyperkey M. The Eclipse commands may be repeated or used in conjunction with the arrow keys. Eclipse uses the term *mark block* for marking or selecting a block of text. The "esc" key unselects or unmarks the text.


How to copy text

Standard Windows Keys: CTRL + C

All caps display:

This will not maintain all caps when outputting to a third-party application (such as RTC).


User settings, Display Tab:
