The National Court Reporters Foundation is pleased to announce that nominations are being solicited for Stenograph's Milton H. Wright Memorial Scholarship, a scholarship worth more than \$5,000 that honors the memory of Milton H. Wright, Stenograph's founder. Students from NCRA-approved court reporter education programs are encouraged to apply. This is a merit-based academic scholarship worth a \$5,000 tuition-award and will include use of a student writer and software.

Stenograph Milton H. Wright Memorial Scholarship eligibility

To be eligible to apply for the NCRF Stenograph Scholarship, students must meet the criteria below:

- Be a current NCRA student member.
- Be enrolled in a court reporting program.
- If in a judicial court reporting program, must have passed at least one of the program's Q & A tests at a minimum of 90+ WPM.
- Have a grade point average of at least a 3.5 overall, based on a 4.0 standard or equivalent.
- Possess all the qualities exemplified by a professional court reporter, including professional attitude, demeanor, dress, and motivation, as confirmed in a separate letter of recommendation.

Document requirements

A complete application packet must contain the following documents:

- Student Scholarship Application Form, page 2.
- Copy of the student's most recent academic transcript.
- Speed verification form, page 3, signed by the student's instructor.
- Essay: Word count 350-425. Discuss how advancements in technology have enhanced the role of stenographic court reporters in ensuring the accuracy of legal transcripts. Highlight specific tools or software that have made a significant impact and how these complement court reporters' and CART captioners' stenographic skills. (Your full name and essay prompt must appear on the top of all essay pages.)
