NCRF Student Intern Scholarship offers two \$1,000 awards



The NCRF Student Intern Scholarship is now open for nominations. Two \$1,000 awards will be given to high-achieving court reporting students who have completed the internship portion of their education. Eligibility requirements include current NCRA student membership, speed test requirements, and a minimum 3.5 GPA. Applicants must be nominated by their court reporting programs and must also submit a letter of recommendation and an essay. The deadline to apply is Dec. 9. 2022.
